Session Times and charges from 1st April 2026

We aim to make our nursery as accessible as possible to families in the community and therefore aim to ensure our fees are as competitive and straightforward as possible.

Session times and charges for 2 year olds

Parents are also able to book ad-hoc sessions (subject to availability). These are charged at £55 per core session. The ad-hoc fees for Breakfast Club remain the same.

Session times for and charges for 3 and 4 year olds

For government funding purposes children are classed as two year olds until the term after they turn three, that is from: 1st April, 1st September and 1st January.

It is essential for planning ratios, fees and places that our fees are in line with this. So if your child turns three between September and December they will start paying the lower rate from the following January – at the same time as they become entitled to the government funding for 3 sessions (or 6 sessions if entitled to 30 hour funding).

Parents are also able to book ad-hoc sessions (subject to availability). These are charged at £46.74 per core session. The ad-hoc fees for Breakfast Club remain the same.

The above fees include Meals and Enhancements

Meals: healthy lunches/teas provided by our onsite café serving fresh and seasonal vegetarian food, a healthy dessert, usually natural yogurt and smoothie or fresh fruit, as well as a healthy snack, consisting of fruit/vegetables and rice cakes/corn cakes etc.

Enhancements: regular Forest School sessions, led by qualified and trained staff, these may be held in the park or nearby, e.g. at the local nature reserve.

Monthly Fees

Fees for your child's sessions are payable one month in advance, so fees for January will be invoiced at the beginning of December and are due on the 1st of January. As a non-profit charity we rely on prompt fee payments to be able to meet our running costs and to provide equipment and resources.

Our monthly fees are worked out by multiplying the weekly fee by 48 weeks/year, then dividing this figure by 12 months to give even payments throughout the year. This also means that your April, August and December invoices will be the same as all the other months, even though they contain some nursery holidays.

Registration fee

A registration fee of £50 is payable with your full application documents to secure a place as soon as one has been offered.

The registration fee is refundable for fully funded children (e.g. those who are accessing the government funded places only). It will be refunded when your child takes up the place and you complete the Parental Declaration for the applicable term.

Deposit

Once your child's sessions have been agreed a refundable deposit will also be required. This is in case there are any outstanding fees when a child leaves the setting and it will be returned upon payment of the final invoice at the end of your child's attendance at our provision. The amount equals a month's fees or £250 whichever is the lower.

A deposit is not required for fully funded children.

Late Collection Fees

We reserve the right to charge £10 for every 15 minutes or part thereof that your child is collected late. This is to cover our increased staffing costs.
